2. Online Courses: Attleboro Library
- need a library card

 - from the "Test Preparation / Career Skills" page, scroll down and click on the "Universal Classes" link

 - if you have already created a username and password, click the "sign in" button
 - check our website to see if class is acceptable; call our office if you are not sure
 - complete course with a passing grade (70% or higher)
 - must be .8 cu or higher
 - print certificate and include with application

- organization must write a letter on their letterhead confirming you volunteered
- include both with your application

3. Finish your HiSET (high school equivalency exam)

- include copy of completion with your application

4. College Courses

- must be from spring or summer sessions in 2017
- have a passing grade of 70% or higher and include copy of transcript with your application
